Year 6	The Arrival- looking at migration	



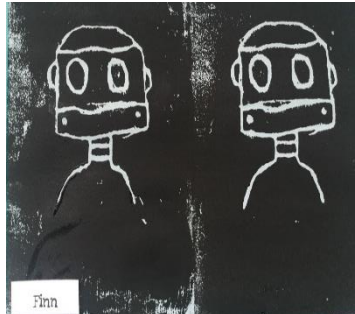
