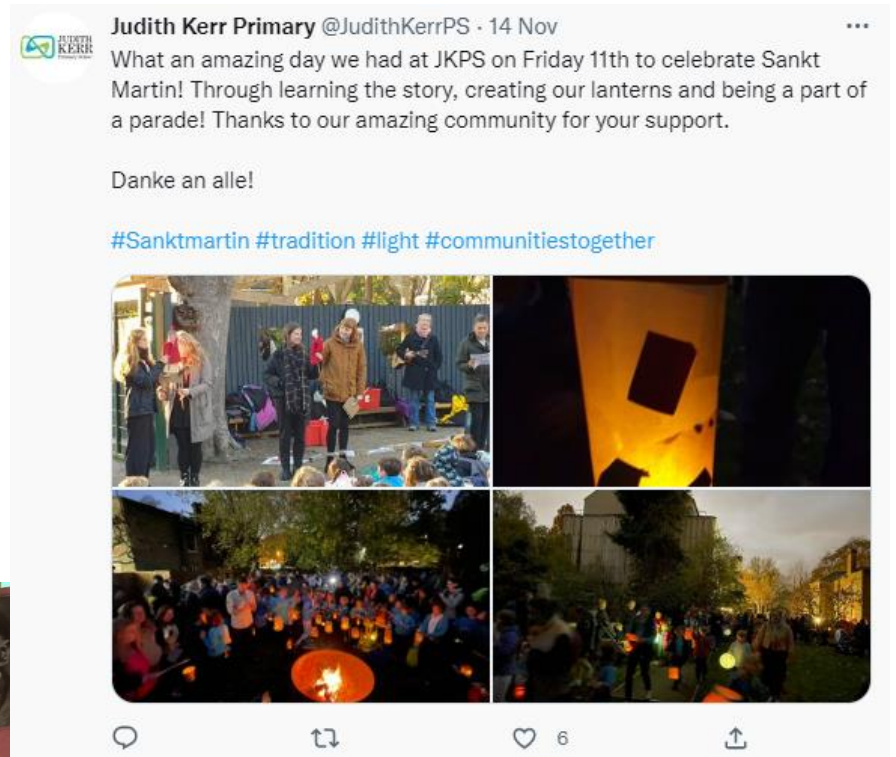
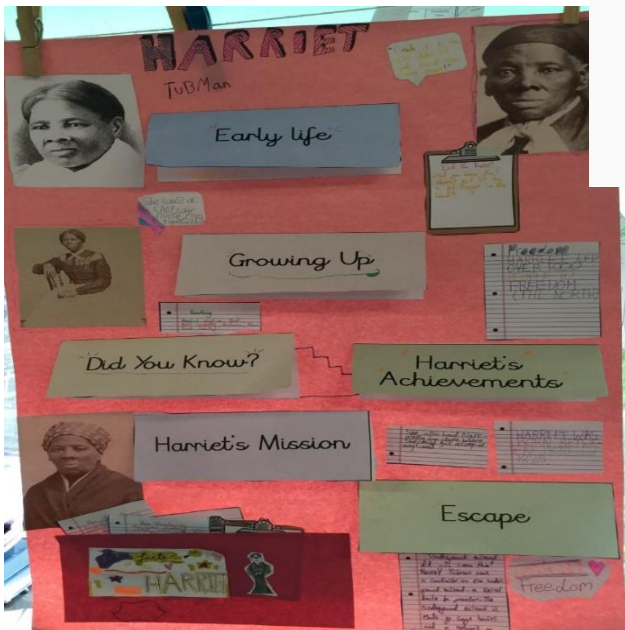

This term Year 5 have been learning about Harriet Tubman and the underground railroad.



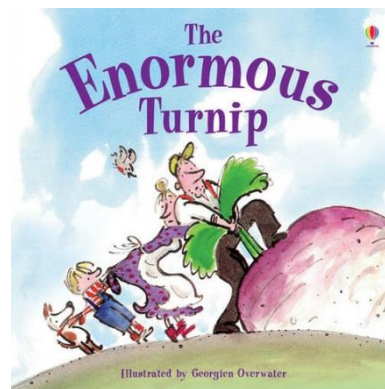
Safeguarding


