### What will the curriculum look like?



New curriculum based around the Literacy Tree- this is a Trust wide approach.





























# Reading

- Take time to ask them questions, make predictions, tell you what they think

- •If at any point-you feel your child is strugglingplease speak to us and we can support you





Maths- Subitising is a term that was coined by the theorist Piaget and defined the ability to instantaneously recognise the number of objects in a small group without the need to count them. Start with two dice and roll them and get the children to find the totals. Then move onto three. As a challenge write down the number sentences.
